2. In verses 43–45, what does Jesus teach about how people come to Him, and what role does the Father play in that process?
3. What does Jesus mean when He says He is the “bread of life” in verses 48–51?
4. Why did many struggle with Jesus’ teaching about eating His flesh and drinking His blood (verses 52–56)?
5. According to verses 57–58, what is the relationship between Jesus, the Father, and those who “feed” on Him?
