

Study in the Book of John - Lesson 14 (Assigned Reading: John 8:1-30)

1. According to the Law of Moses (Leviticus 20:10), what was the required penalty for this sin, and why was their trap for Jesus particularly cunning regarding Roman law (John 8:1-6)?
2. How does Jesus' response in John 8:7 ("He who is without sin...") challenge our attitudes toward judging others today? (*See also Matthew 7:1-5.*)
3. What can we learn about mercy and accountability from Jesus' interaction with the woman in John 8:10-11?
4. In John 8:12, Jesus declares, "I am the light of the world." What does this statement mean, and how does it connect to spiritual darkness? (*Compare with 1 John 1:5-7.*)
